



## Twitter Chat Etiquette


1. On Twitter, welcome guests as they come in to the chat. Encourage people to say hello.
2. The Guest Moderator posts questions every 12 minutes, starting at just after 3pm Eastern Time. (So... ~3:03pm, ~3:15pm, ~3:27pm, ~3:39pm, ~3:51pm) This allows time for the Host (@SexTalkTuesday) to introduce you and time for you to talk back and forth with individuals between questions. Questions must be posted in the following format: "Q1 (insert question text here) #SexTalkTuesday". Always end every tweet with #SexTalkTuesday
3. The Host (@SexTalkTuesday) will help the Guest Moderator (You) move things along and keep Twitter Chat Etiquette in place by giving alerts that the next question is coming up and helping people move from one question to the other.
4. Don't forget to thank everyone for coming at the end of the chat.
5. Have fun and enjoy the chat. :-)

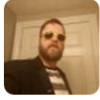
### Example response:

## Tools

We recommend using Hootsuite ([www.hootsuite.com](http://www.hootsuite.com)) or Tweetdeck ([www.tweetdeck.com](http://www.tweetdeck.com)) to participate in the chat.

Create a panel with a search for the chat hashtag [#sextalktuesday](#) to keep track of everyone using the hashtag.

You can also use TweetChat ([www.tweetchat.com](http://www.tweetchat.com)). This is great for tweeting without having to add the chat hashtag because it will automatically add it to all your tweets. However, there is about a 5 second delay in receiving the tweets which can be bad if you are in a very active chat.
